Dubbo Regional Council (DRC) councillors met for the Irst Standing Committee Meetings of 2023 on Friday, 9 March.

INFRASTRUCTURE, PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE:

REPORT OF THE CLIMATE CHANGE AND RESILIENCE COMMITTEE - MEETING 29 NOVEMBER 2022: The Committee noted the reports from the Climate Change and Resilience Committee held on 29 November 2022 and 28 February 2023.

BUILDING SUMMARY - FEBRUARY 2023: The Committee noted the report from the Director Development and Environment regarding the Building Summary for February 2023. It was discussed the overall value was tracking well and while single dwellings were down the total value remains steady due to a resilient market.

REPORT OF THE YOUTH COUNCIL - MEETING 7 FEBRUARY 2023: The Committee noted the report of the Youth Council meeting with

It was the Irst villages Committee with the expanded membership which now means a full representation from most villages in the Local Government Area (LGA).
