Dubbo Regional Council Mayor Mathew Dickerson said the colouring-in

"We wanted to encourage our community members to really get into the spirit of the holiday season and the colouring-in competition was a way we could do that with the children," Clr Dickerson said.

"It was just one of the activities that have been available over the past month for families with others including the Jingle Bucks competition and the Elf Hunt. The Elf Hunt is still going, and children have until the end of the month to Ind 10 elves and bring their collection form to the Visitor Information Centres in Dubbo or Wellington to claim their prize."
