



## TEMPORARY EVENTS: SIGNAGE / BANNERS

### Guidelines

Signage for temporary events must comply with the following in accordance with the relevant legislation\*:

- a) Temporary banners and/or signs may be installed at the venue where the event is to be held in accordance with any requirements of the venue manager / hire agreement.
- b) A temporary banner and/or sign (not exceeding 6m<sup>2</sup> combined) may be installed off-site, based on the following:
  - Must have land owner/occupier consent
  - Must not be placed in residential areas
  - Must not be placed on any public land or assets
  - Must not be permanently fixed
  - Must not incorporate any illumination, bill posters or bunting
  - Signage must not be displayed earlier than 14 days before the event and must be removed within 2 days after the event.

The only public asset that can be used for banner display is the Jubilee Oval fence on the corner of Birch and Wheelers Lane.

You are reminded that it is a littering offence to place flyers on car windscreens or use bill posters (for example, on the outside of buildings or on telegraph poles). Local businesses may be open to display material such as posters and flyers in their windows or within their premises.
