

LEVEL 2 WATER RESTRICTIONS

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Dubbo Regional Council is implementing Level 2 Water Restrictions across the Local Government Area in a proactive response to the region's Drought.

From Saturday 1 June 2019 Level 2 Water Restrictions are in place. Council requests all water users comply with the activity restrictions.

An odds and evens system is being implemented. For further information on this system please see overleaf or visit Council's webpage dubbo.nsw.gov.au.



Watering of Lawns & Gardens (Residential and Non-residential)

Garden beds, trees, shrubs and lawns permitted with watering systems, sprinklers, hand held hoses, microsprays, drip systems and soaker hoses.

Between 7am to 10am and between 4pm and 7pm as per odds and evens system.

Irrigation of turf permitted for one week after laying after which level 2 restriction on watering lawns applies.



Topping up and filling of private and public swimming pools/spas

Only between hours of 7am to 9am and between 6pm to 8pm every day.



Washing cars at home

Permitted with bucket and rinse with trigger hose on lawn between 9am to 12pm any day.



Washing down walls or paved surfaces

Not permitted.

WATERING CALENDAR



ODDS & EVENS SYSTEM EXPLAINED

If the street number of your property is odd you can water in accordance with the restrictions on odd days (blue).

If your property has an even number you can water in accordance with the restrictions on even days (green).

If your property has a range of street numbers then it should be treated as odd or even as per the first number in the range.

For example if your property is 12-15 Smith Street

then you can water on even days in accordance with the restrictions.

If your property has no street number then it should be treated as an even property. For example if your property is "Tara" then you can water on even days in accordance with the restrictions.
