Notes:

1. To install a private pipeline in a Council controlled road reserve you will require approval to construct the pipeline and to remain in the road reserve. Approval is only considered where Council would not be exposed to any liability for installation or existence of the pipeline, and the existence of the pipeline has no detrimental effect on public use of the road and/or road reserve. Should Council approve your application, conditions will be imposed.
2. Typical conditions applicable to pipeline installations include (but are not limited to):
 - Submission of detailed engineering drawings;
 - The alignment and depth of the pipeline being as directed by Council’s Manager Transport and Emergency;
 - Installation of the pipeline in accordance with Council’s Aus-spec specifications;
 - The pipe being installed inside sleeving pipe at road crossings;
 - Traffic control plans (approved by Council) being implemented prior, during and post all onsite activities;
 - Disturbances of natural ground incorporating soil erosion and sedimentation control measures;
 - The cost of all such works including reinstatement of existing road pavements and bitumen surfacing being met by the applicant/s to the satisfaction of Council;
 - Council being indemnified by the applicant/s from any damages up to a value of \$20 M to Council’s assets or claims for damages as a results of the installation and operation (or failure) of the pipeline;
 - Alignment and depth of the pipeline clearly defined by permanent marker posts;
 - Submission of ‘as constructed’ plans;
 - Notification requirement for any change in circumstances;
 - Removal or relocation requirement at end of use, or if Council directs;
 - Signing a formal agreement committing the applicant/s to compliance with the conditions of the approval.
3. Conditions relating to the approval to allow a private underground pipeline to occupy space within the road reserve are enforced through a formal agreement between Council and the pipeline owner/s.
4. Supporting documentation explaining the need for the pipeline and a plan showing details of the proposed pipeline (eg location, pipe size and type) must accompany the application.
5. Any approval to allow a private pipeline in a road reserve will only become effective when an agreement is signed committing the applicant/s to compliance with the conditions of approval.
6. Approvals are issued to the current property owner/s who will own the pipeline. Any subsequent property owner/s who intend to use the pipeline will need to apply to Council for transfer of the pipeline agreement for the continued existence/operation of the pipeline.

NOTE: Applications for approval to allow an underground private pipeline in the road reserve must be submitted to Council with the prescribed fee for Section 138 Applications per the current Dubbo Regional Council Revenue Policy.
