CONDITIONS OF USE

General Conditions

We appreciate, in advance, your cooperation and understanding of the terms and conditions for using Council's parks and gardens:

1. Parks and gardens are a public space and therefore exclusiveness to an area booked for an event is not guaranteed.
2. Parks and gardens are to be used in the condition they appear.
3. Parks and garden areas are to be left clean and tidy. Any litter control required by Council will be invoiced to the user.
4. Dubbo Regional Council parks and gardens are an alcohol free zone between 9pm and 9am daily, responsible consumption is required. Cameron Park is located in a total alcohol free zone.
5. Electric barbeques are available at specific parks free of charge.
6. No access to power is available.

7. No confetti is to be used.

8. Marquees or shade shelters may only be erected if weights or pegs no larger than 200mm in length and 5mm in width are used due to underground services. Written approval from Council is required for use of marquees with large pegs, star pickets or poles and will require marking of underground services which may incur additional charges.

9. Bikes, skateboards and unauthorised vehicles are not permitted.

10. Vehicles required for mobility by individuals in accordance with Roads and Maritime Services standards are permitted to use the Victoria Park internal road on written request through Council.

11. For the use of jumping castles in Council parks and gardens areas, the provider must have \$20,000,000 Public Liability Insurance to comply, and any injury or incident will be the responsibility of the user.

12. Any unsafe parks or gardens should not be used and reported to Council immediately on 6801 4000. Calls are logged using this service and allocated to the appropriate staff to arrange an inspection and for the work to be carried out to fix faults.

13. Note major events are likely to run at Ollie Robbins, Macquarie Lions, Victoria Park, Sir Roden Cutler Park, Elizabeth Park and Cameron Park.

14. Applications for bookings of community organisation events and weddings are available from the Dubbo Regional Council website.

15. Any damage caused as a result of a user will be invoiced.

Wedding Conditions (in addition to the above)

1. For the Dubbo Regional Botanic Garden signage informing the public of a wedding will be placed in the booked area.

2. At the Dubbo Botanic Garden the bridal party and all wedding guests must have exited the gardens by 4pm otherwise the additional costs which apply beyond 4pm will be invoiced to the booking contact.

3. Bridal vehicles are permitted to use the internal road at Victoria Park, but all other vehicles are to park on the adjacent streets.

Please note: Horse riding, dogs (not a leash), animals, lighting of fires, practising of golf, camping and removal of shrubs and trees are prohibited in ALL parks and gardens.
