

## GEURIE POOL OPENING SOON

The summer is set to start soon at Geurie Pool with works undertaken by Dubbo Regional Council completed on time and ready for the commencement of the swimming season.

“The Geurie Pool will open on Saturday 12 November after work was undertaken to replace the chlorination system,” Council Director Parks and Landcare Services Ian McAlister said.

“The new system brings the pools plant room in line with current standards.”

Geurie Pool is open during weekdays from 6am to 7am for the morning session and 3.30pm to 7pm for the day session and during weekends and school holidays from 6am to 7am for the early session and 11.30am to 7pm for the day session. The pool is closed Christmas Day.

Price of entry is \$3 for adults, \$2 for children and \$2 for pensioners with discount books of 10 tickets and season passes available.

Season passes are available for purchase from Dubbo Regional Council offices located at on the corner of Church and Darling streets Dubbo, the Wellington branch located on the corner of Nanima Crescent and Warne Street, Wellington and the Geurie Pool.
