

## BAIRD DRIVE, SPRINGFIELD WAY INTERSECTION ROAD REPAIRS

Major pavement damaged was caused last week by a burst water main, at Baird Drive and Springfield Way intersection. Council has repaired the water main and undertaken initial pavement repairs to allow traffic to continue to travel along Baird Drive.

Temporary traffic control measures are in place and the site will continue to be monitored until more permanent repairs can be undertaken.

The permanent pavement repairs will be undertaken this coming weekend Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2018 and Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> August 2018, weather permitting. These repairs will be undertaken outside normal working hours on a weekend to minimise impacts to weekday traffic on Baird Drive.
