

GOONOO STATE FOREST FIRE - ROAD CLOSURES

Due to a fire in the Goonoo State Forest which is impacting on the Mendooran Rd, the following road closures are in place

- For traffic heading south from Mendooran towards Dubbo: The Mendooran Rd is closed at Mendooran, and traffic is being diverted to Gilgandra or Dunedoo
- For traffic heading north from Dubbo towards Mendooran: The Mendooran Rd is closed at the Mendooran Rd/Mogriguy Rd intersection to through traffic
- For residents who live along Mendooran Rd north of the Mendooran Rd/Mogriguy intersection: Access is permitted up to the intersection of Mendooran Rd and Freeman's Trail, where the Mendooran Rd is closed to all traffic north of this intersection.

These road closures are likely to be in place overnight.

WATCH & ACT – Forest Rd fire, Dubbo
The fire is burning near Forest Road, Mendooran in the Goonoo National Park, approximately 50km north east of Dubbo. The fire is burning in a south east direction towards Boomley and Ballimore. There is a thunderstorm in the area that is soon to pass over the fireground, which will produce erratic winds gusting up to 90km/h, while the storm passes. A forecast wind change is expected in the area between 6pm and 8pm. There is no immediate threat to isolated rural properties in the area, however residents should monitor conditions, take advice from firefighters in the area and follow their bush fire survival plan.
