The Dubbo Regional Theatre and Convention Centre (DRTCC) 2022 season opener is a cabaret like no other – *Club Soda*.

Showing on Saturday 22 January at the Convention Centre, tickets are on sale now and can be bought individually or you can book a table to revisit the 1920s with a group of friends.
