

SMOKESCREEN SETS THE SCENE IN 2024

Lovers of stylish cinema are invited to experience iconic elegance of 11 Ims as part of the Western Plains Cultural Centres (WPCC) 2024 Smokescreen series.

Smokescreen offers the Dubbo community a chance to enjoy, celebrate and ponder world-class llms in a fun and friendly environment.

Each year, Smokescreen 'Ims are selected based on a specilic theme and curated by a staff member from the WPCC Cultural Development team.

Local Studies O[°]cer Simone Taylor jumped at the opportunity last year and will again host the Smokescreen series in 2024, with *Scene Stealing Style* as the chosen theme.

"Scene Stealing Style looks at how art direction helps bring a story to life visually; how the look and feel of the 'Im adds to the storytelling experience for the audience," Ms Taylor said.

"If you think about your favourite 'Im, it's likely one particular moment stands out, that captures something essential."

"Think Steve McQueen §ying through the streets of San Francisco in his 1968 Ford Mustang from *Bullitt* or the four young schoolgirls leaving for a school picnic at the mysterious *Hanging Rock*. These are moments in 'Im that leave lasting impressions."

The 2024 Smokescreen series showcases an array of lms covering a variety of genres including romance, thrillers, blaxploitation, mystery and horror.

Film enthusiasts can buy a season pass which includes admission to all 11 ¦Im screenings and an after-movie buy-one-get-one-free drink voucher at partnering business, The Establishment Bar.

"Those who come along may not have heard of some of the lms in the program, but each is iconic and, in its own way, set standards and shaped later generations of lmmaking."

"Whether you're revisiting old favourites or discovering new Ilms, Smokescreen is a must-see event for any movie enthusiast."

In line with Councils SPARC Cultural Plan, Smokescreen provides an opportunity to foster community engagement with IIm that is open and inclusive.

Smokescreen will be held in the Drama Room at the WPCC on the Irst Saturday of each month, starting on Saturday 3 February at 4pm.
