Council has developed a procedure to calculate the daily average water consumption in Dubbo, Geurie and Wellington.

Council encourages residents to be Wise With Our Water and aim at using approximately 380- 400 litres per person per day (292.1KB).

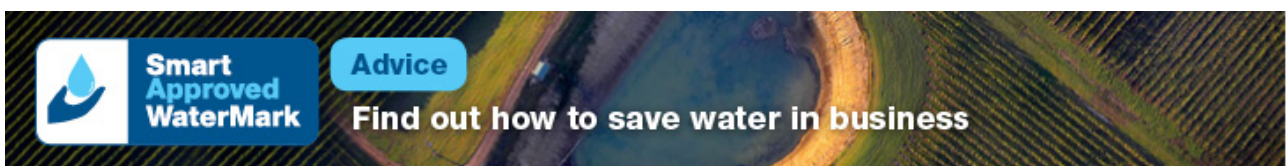
MONITORING YOUR WATER USAGE

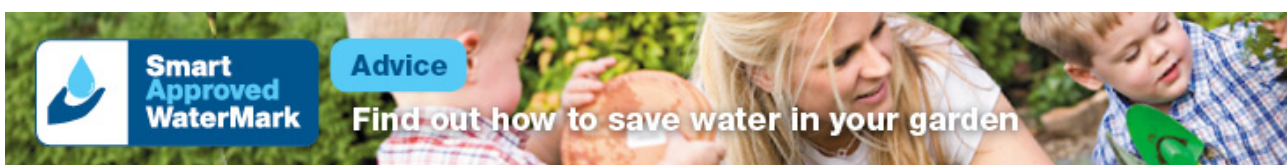

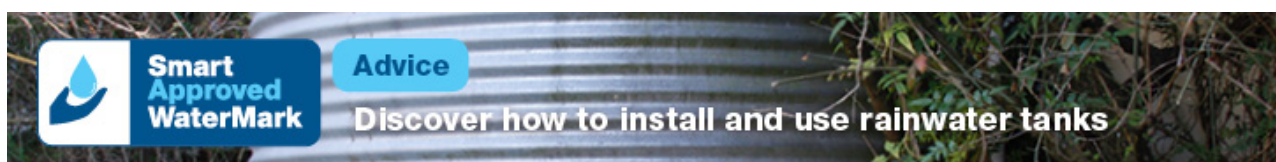

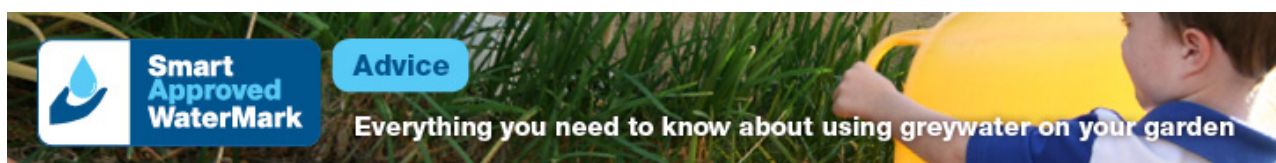
